# BIOGRAPHY

Described by Flute Focus as "...having shattered any notions that the piccolo might be lacking in deep, expressive powers," Christine Erlander Beard enjoys an active international career as a soloist, chamber artist and teacher throughout North America, South America and Europe. Noted for her "warm lyricism" (BFS journal, Pan), and "great expressive tone and range" (Christopher Caliendo, composer), Christie strives to showcase expressive music written for the flute and piccolo as well as promoting new and original works by living composers. Passionate about collaborating with composers, she has commissioned and/or premiered dozens of new works from composers across the globe with a strong focus on music of the Americas. Engagements in 2018 included flute festivals in Canada, Ecuador, Honduras, France, and her 15th appearance on the program of the National Flute Association Convention: 2019 includes performances in Latvia, Belgium, Canada, Costa Rica, Brazil and Japan. Founder and Artistic Director of the International Piccolo Symposium, Christine also serves the NFA as a member of the Piccolo Committee and as a contributing editor to the NFA's journal, The Flutist Quarterly. An international solo artist for Sankyo Flutes and piccolo artist for Hernandez Flutes, she is the Regents-Foundation Professor of Flute and International Studies at the University of Nebraska at Omaha, where she has served since 2002. www.christiebeard.com.
